TRIED & TESTED

Musgrove Willows now grow more than 60 different varieties of willow on over 180 acres of Somerset farmland.

QUALITY SERVICE

Musgrove Willows has been weaving willow coffins on a commercial basis for over a decade.

Every coffin is made on site with willow grown and processed here. This enables us to maintain exceptionally high standards of quality and service.

In 2017, Musgrove Willows received accreditation from the Funeral Furnishing Manufacturers' Association. Our coffins have passed rigorous testing for weight, strength and environmental impact.

ECO-FRIENDLY

The Somerset Levels provide ideal growing conditions for willow, an incredibly sustainable and eco-friendly crop.

A willow cutting takes around three years to become established absorbing carbon as it grows. The willow stump then provides rods which can be harvested every year for about 60 years.

Musgrove Willows practice a carbon neutral policy. No fossil fuels are used to boil or steam the willow. Rainwater is harvested and willow offcuts are turned into keepsakes, charcoal or burned as fuel.

Our team work sensitively with the environment using good land management to maintain a natural balance of wildlife and high quality crop production.

PERSONAL TOUCH

Many of the coffins are named after an area in which our willow is grown or a place close to our farm.

Each coffin and casket can be customised and a bespoke service is available. All our coffins are lined with environmentally friendly materials making them suitable for burial, cremation, woodland and green burial sites.

Only natural dyes are used to colour the willow and the coffin linings. Coffins can be made to a specific design and size in just 48 hours. The colour(s) of the coffin, plait, handles, bows, and bands can all be customised.

HELP TO WEAVE

Children, parents and grandparents have all come here to help weave a coffin for a loved one.

This service is provided free of charge. It's an opportunity for family members to get together and make a really positive contribution. Many find the weaving cathartic. Personal touches can make such a difference and our skilled weavers are happy to accommodate special requests.

Please advise your Funeral Director if you would like to take part in the weaving process. A suitable day can then be arranged. Some come and weave for an hour, others spend the whole day here.

Families unable to visit can use our live streaming service to watch their chosen coffin being made. Please contact us for further information.

SEDGEMOOR & SOUTHLAKE

The **Sedgemoor** and **Southlake** are woven with buff willow.

The Sedgemoor is a traditional shape while the Southlake has a curved end.







BLACKDOWN & MENDIP

Buff willow is used in the main body of the **Blackdown** and the **Mendip**. Dark brown steamed willow is used for the banding and the plait border on the lid edge.

The handles, bands and plait can be woven in antique buff, barked, buff, steamed, white and/or natural dyed willow.

The Blackdown is a traditional shape while the Mendip has a curved end.





POLDEN & QUANTOCK

The main body of the **Polden** and the **Quantock** is woven with buff willow. White willow is used for the plait on the lid edge and for the banding.

The Polden is a traditional shape while the Quantock has a curved end.









GLASTONBURY & HAY MOOR

The **Glastonbury** and **Hay**

Moor are woven entirely with steamed willow. These striking coffins are designed to provide an alternative to mahogany wood.

WICK MOOR & MOORLAND

The Wick Moor and Moorland are woven with barked willow. Choose antique buff, barked, buff, steamed or white willow for the lid and handles. Toggles enhance the natural feel.

The Wick Moor is a traditional shape while the Moorland has a curved end.

AVALON

The **Avalon** is woven entirely with white willow. White willow is not paper white as the natural processing of the willow results in a slightly cream colour.

The Avalon is available in a traditional shape or with a curved end.

WEST MOOR

The **West Moor** is woven entirely with antique buff willow which is often referred to as 'weather-beaten gold'.

Available in a traditional shape or with a curved end.









RAINBOW

Our rainbow collection features Rainbow, Rainbow Twist and Rainbow Light.

Natural dyed willow is used to create these stunning designs which can be customised with the addition of antique buff, barked, buff, steamed or white willow. Coloured toggles can be incorporated.

The Rainbow coffin is available with a curved end or in a traditional shape and can be customised to incorporate different colour stripes.





RAINBOW TWIST & RAINBOW LIGHT

The **Rainbow Twist** is available with a plain lid and plait or in a multi-coloured design. The plain lid and plait can be woven in antique buff, barked, buff, steamed or white willow.








Seven subtle coloured bands are woven into the **Rainbow Light**. The lid and main body of the coffin can be woven in antique buff, barked, buff, steamed or white willow.



BLOCK COLOUR

Our **Block Colour** coffins are woven predominately with natural dyed willow.

The lid, plait, bands and handles can be made from either antique buff, barked, buff, steamed or white willow.





Choose either red, orange, yellow, dark green, light green, dark blue, light blue, lilac, purple, light pink, fuchsia pink, dark grey, light grey, burgundy, black or turquoise.

Block Colour coffins are available in a traditional shape or with a curved end.



FULL COLOUR

Our **Full Colour** coffins are woven in natural dyed willow. Simply choose the colour from our comprehensive range.

Full Colour coffins are available in a traditional shape or with a curved end.

Available in red, orange, yellow, dark green, light green, dark blue, light blue, lilac, purple, light pink, fuchsia pink, dark grey, light grey, burgundy, black or turquoise.





BABY CRADLES & CRIBS

Our **Baby Nestling Cradle** is a Moses basket style casket with a raised hood end. It is hand woven in white willow. Each cradle is lined and can be hand finished with bows and natural white toggle fastenings.

A name plaque is included.
A keepsake flower is made from the willow used to weave the cradle and sent to the family.











Our **Baby Nestling Crib** is an oval style casket woven in white willow. Each crib is lined and can be finished with bows and natural white toggle fastenings.

A name plaque is included. The family is also given a willow keepsake flower. Both our Nestling Cradle and Crib can be customised to incorporate personal touches such as coloured bands and bows.

The Children's Funeral Fund for England can help to pay for the cost of a coffin or casket for those under 18. It is not means-tested but the burial or cremation must take place in England.

ASHES CASKETS

Our hand woven **ashes caskets** are available in an oval, rectangular or square shape. They can be made to match any of our coffins.

Coloured banding can be incorporated into the design and full colour caskets are also available.

Each casket is fitted with a handmade interior cotton drawstring ashes pouch and a nameplate is included.

LINERS

Natural calico liners, frilled liners, mattresses and pillows are available. Our liners are handmade and hand-fitted prior to dispatch. Natural dyes are used to make our coloured liners.

NAMEPLATES

Our nameplates are made from sustainably sourced oak.

Grave markers can be supplied for green burials.





WILLOW

Please be aware that willow is a natural product and the colour and/or finish of your chosen coffin may differ slightly from the images shown in the brochure and in other promotional material.



Buff willow & antique buff willow

ANTIQUE BUFF

Also known as stripped willow, this is a natural barked or green willow which has been boiled and then stripped of its bark and dried. The variety of willow used in these natural processes produces a smooth golden willow rod.

DYED WILLOW

Only natural dyes are used. To achieve the best possible finish only white willow is dyed. The willow is dyed by hand, so each batch may vary slightly.



BUFF WILLOW

The natural processes used to produce buff willow are the same as those for antique buff. By using a different variety of willow, a smooth orange/brown rod is produced.

NATURAL BARKED OR BROWN WILLOW

This is natural willow which has been dried with
its bark on.

STEAMED WILLOW

Brown willow is placed in a boiler for a few hours to colour it a chocolate / black colour. When the willow is removed from the boiler it is left to dry outside.

WHITE WILLOW

Our highest quality green willow is freshly cut in winter and 'pitted' (left to stand in water until the sap rises in the spring). The willow is then stripped of its bark (without boiling) to leave a white colour rod. White willow is not paper white and can look a little cream in colour.
